

1. Credits and reference emissions of JCM projects 🎇 JCM 🏬




- Mitigation outcomes issued as <u>JCM credits are the difference between</u> reference emissions and project emissions.
- Reference emissions are specified in methodologies <u>considering the</u> <u>latest NDC of a partner country</u>.
- This <u>conservative way</u> of evaluation of mitigation outcomes is <u>consistent</u> with <u>Article 6</u> and relevant guidelines.



2. Total mitigation outcomes by JCM projects



- Total mitigation outcomes by JCM projects are the difference between BaU and project emissions, consisting of
 - > NOT issued as JCM credits
 - Issued as JCM credits acquired by a partner country and Japan
- Mitigation outcomes NOT issued as JCM credits and issued as JCM credits acquired by a partner country will be <u>reflected in the partner country's inventory and contribute to achieving its NDC</u>



3. Allocation of total mitigation outcomes



- Allocation of total mitigation outcomes by each government and project participants will be consulted bilaterally, taking into consideration their respective contributions to the JCM project.
 - <Examples of contribution>
 - Private and public financial contributions
 - In-kind contributions, such as technical and operational contributions.
